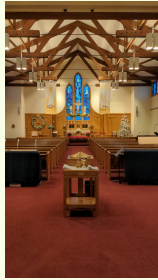


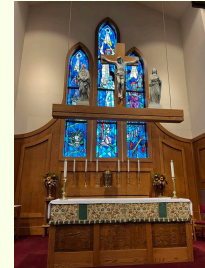
Here at St. Anne's there are many ways to be involved.

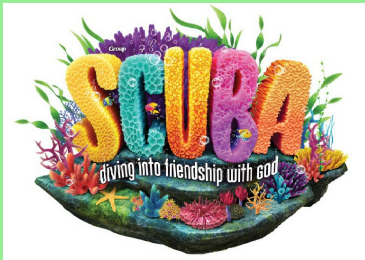
Usually two members are assigned to the weekend. They decide when to meet to set up the service for Sunday. Historically on Saturday at 9am.

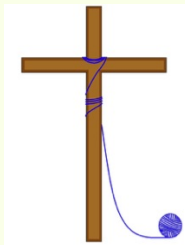

These days, we can't seem to avoid high prices at the pump – or at the store or other service providers either.

But at least we can support St. Anne's when we're making our essential purchases if we use Scrip cards!

Purchase cards after church services or on our website and use them like cash in store or online. St. Anne's benefits by obtaining them at a discount and earning on each card.

You can also get Scrip order forms online

at www.stannesdeperre.org and send your order as an email to stannes.scrip@gmail. The deadline to order is 2 pm every Sunday. Payment can be made by cash or check. If you'd like to use a credit card, you will need to use the RaiseRight app (look for directions on our website), and a fee is charged.

Or – if your card has a round R sticker on it – you can add money to it and keep using it through the RaiseRight app or letting your Scrip team know what you'd like to add.

If you don't see a card for a business you go to, just ask – we may be able to get one for you.

And, as always, if you've got an extra 15 mins after the service to help work the scrip table, please let us know.

Training takes only a couple of minutes, and your support is much appreciated!

Prayer Chain

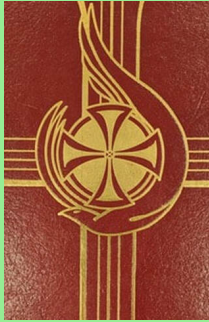
Purpose of the prayer chain is to pray together for the needs of the congregation and the world.
