*The prayer group meets every Thursday at 6:30 in the Prayer Room at St. Anne's. All are welcome!*

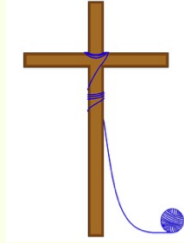

Or – if your card has a round R sticker on it – you can add money to it and keep using it through the RaiseRight app or letting your Scrip team know what you'd like to add.

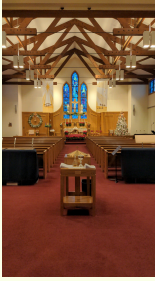
If you don't see a card for a business you go to, just ask – we may be able to get one for you.

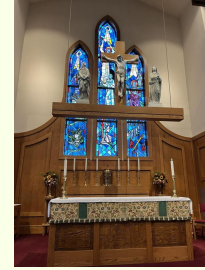

## Altar Guild

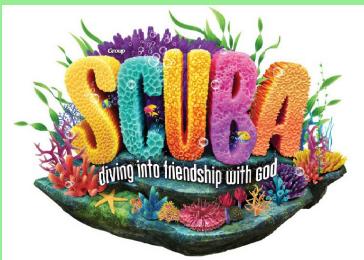
